

Therapeutic Stabilization Center For Youth



The Village Network Therapeutic Stabilization Center is now offering short-term residential care for youth ages 10 to 21 who are experiencing immediate psychological or emotional crises. The 16 bed coed center allows youth to receive treatment, while keeping them close to their families, doctors and schools.

Admittance Criteria

A youth must meet at least one of the following criteria for entrance into the center.

- The youth must demonstrate active symptoms consistent with a DSM diagnosis that requires brief, intensive & structured intervention.
- The youth's condition indicates a strong potential for danger to self or others and cannot be safely maintained in a less restrictive level of care.
- A less intensive or restrictive level of care has been considered or tried.
- The youth demonstrates a significant, incapacitating or debilitating disturbance in mood, thought or behavior that interferes with activities of daily living.
- The youth is at risk for disruption in their current living environment.

Exclusions

If a youth is subject to any of the following exclusions, they will not be allowed entrance into the center.

- The youth's psychiatric condition is of such severity that it can only be safely treated in an inpatient setting that is embedded within a hospital.
- The youth's medical condition is such that it can only be safely treated in a medical hospital.
- The youth can be safely maintained and effectively treated in a less intensive level of care.
- The primary problem is social, economic or one of physical health without a concurrent major psychiatric episode meeting criteria for this level of care.
- The youth is actively detoxing (i.e., last use must be at least 72 hours and at least 24 hours since last physical withdrawal symptoms).
- The youth has bulimia/anorexia as their primary diagnosis or requires a medical diet.
- Admission is being used as an alternative to incarceration.
- If a youth tests positive for ethyl alcohol they will require medical clearance.
- If a youth's full scale IQ is below 65
