## OUR Children Community CARE Team

Our community CARE Team is a team of multi-system, youth-serving agencies that serves as a hub of collaboration. This group will provide the referring professional or parent with information about available supports and services to meet the needs of the identified youth at risk with the goal of improving the likelihood of success now and for the future.

### Do you have a child with non-academic barriers to learning such as:

- Aggressive behaviors
- Disruptive in the classroom
- Basic needs are not being met
- Truancy
- Trauma and tragedy in the family
- Detentions, Suspensions, Expulsions
- Suicidal thoughts and gestures



Please feel free to make a referral to Community CARE Team for youth who are not involved with services, but who could benefit from community connection to services and supports.

CARE Team Meetings are held 9-10:30am on the 3rd Thursday of the month at the Tuscarawas County Board of Developmental Disabilities at 610 Commercial Ave SW New Philadelphia. A virtual option is available for those who cannot attend in person.
